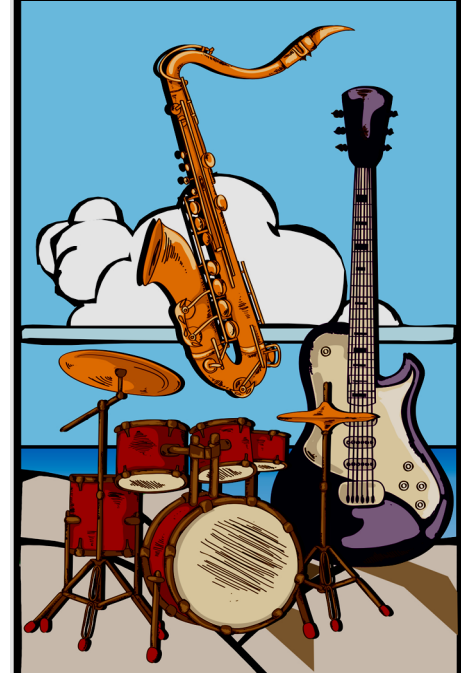

Internationally renowned recording artist, Rodney Whitaker, is Director of Jazz

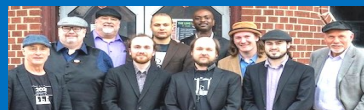
